In actions or behaviors this looks like...

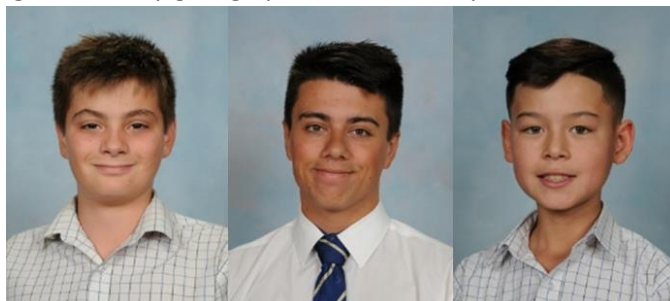
1. Write down your goals- how can I improve?
