Dear Parents / Guardians,

This Thursday the 5th May, St Edmund's College is hosting our annual Founder's Day. It is a day where we recognise the founder of the Christian Brother's Blessed Edmund Rice and the work and traditions he began for the community of Christian Brothers.

The day will begin with a College Mass to be held at the Cathedral. Students will need to be at school on time as we will walk to the Cathedral for a 9:30am Mass. Students are not to be dropped directly at the Cathedral unless prior permission has been sought from students Head of House.

Following the conclusion of Mass, students will return to school for a day of House games and activities and participation in the Eddie's Fair. Stalls for the Eddie's Fair are being organised and run by the senior Hospitality and Business Studies students and all proceeds will go towards the College.

Eddie's Fair Coupons:

In the days leading up to Thursday, students are able to purchase coupons for the various stalls and food vendors. A price list of items is attached. Coupons purchased will be given out to students on Thursday morning prior to the opening of the stalls. Whilst cash is preferred, students may buy coupons using the Eftpos machine at the College. The coupon stand will be open out on the Quad before school (from 8:15am), during recess and at lunch time where students are able to pre-order their coupons. Please note that the front office will not be taking payments for coupons. Students will be able to purchase last minute coupons on Thursday – but this is not encouraged as we are trying to avoid long queues.

Uniform and Eddie's Attire:

Students must wear their full College uniform, including their blazer to school and to the Cathedral on Thursday. Students are not to wear their puffer jacket to the Cathedral. Once students have returned from the Cathedral, they are able to change into Blue and White attire or St Edmund's clothing (retro or recent). Boys are encouraged to get changed as the remainder of the day will involve more active games and activities. Students will not have to change back into their St Edmund's uniform at the end of the day.
