THE ROLE OF HOST

- The host does not have to be a teacher, an ‘answers person’, a good talker or a strong personality.

The role of host in the family group sessions is essentially **to guide the group through each session.**

- Host support is available from the Religious Education Coordinators at Holy Trinity and Sts Peter & Paul Primary schools and the Parish Office.
- **The host must hold, or have applied for, a Working with Vulnerable People (WWVP) card.**
 - If you don’t have a WWVP card, you can complete an online application.

 - As a volunteer, there is no cost for you to apply for a WWVP card.
