

# St Edmund's College BYOD Requirements



## Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

All students in Years 6 - 12 are expected to bring their own computing device to school every day. These devices will be used in classrooms to support student learning.

## What type of device is allowed?

Students can bring either a laptop or a tablet with a physical keyboard attachment. The device **must** follow the required specifications listed below. **Please note that iPads and Chromebooks are not supported.**



## Required Specifications



### Operating System

Microsoft Windows 10 or Windows 11  
MacOS 13 or newer



### Battery Life

Advertised battery life of at least 6 hours without charging.



### Wireless Connectivity

Both 2.4GHz and 5GHz bands are supported for wireless and includes:

802.11ax  
802.11ac  
802.11n  
802.11a/b/g

May also be written as:  
**Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 6E**



### Screen Size

**Minimum** screen size: 9.7"



### Protection

The device must have virus and malware protection.

The device should have a protective case/cover.
